Dear Families of LADH,

I want to thank you for your patience as the phone lines are still out of order. We are working diligently with LCPS and Century Link to get our phones working to better serve you. What is the earliest time students may be dropped off?

A staff member will be on duty by 7:40 am; therefore, you may begin to drop off students at 7:40 am.

What is the latest time students may be picked up?

Dismissal is at 3:30; therefore, all students should be picked up by 3:45 (as staff is no longer on duty). However, we are in the process of obtaining more information from the City of Las Cruces Weed & Seed Program which is available at no cost but they are still working on finalizing the program. Therefore, more information should be available before July 30th as this is when registration for the Weed & Seed Program begins. We have also received information from the Boys and Girls Club of Las Cruces. They will begin registration next Monday, July 23rd at 330 W. Las Cruces Ave. There is a fee of \$10 per semester **PLUS** the follow fee:

Full-time (3-5 days)

1st child: \$35/week

2nd child: \$30/week

3rd child: \$25/week

Part-time (1-2 days)

1st child: \$20/week

2nd child: \$15/week

3rd child: \$10/week

The fee includes a full meal and after school transportation to the Boys and Girls Club along with homework assistance and other programs available. Students need to be picked up by 6:30 pm at the Boys and Girls Club. For further information please contact the Boys & Girls Club at 575-526-1519.

The Weed & Seed and the Boys & Girls Club are the two program we have been in contact with to help families who need assistance with an afterschool program. We will keep you updated with any changes.
