Attached are four sample letters that may be of use to individuals who are La Academia Dolores Huerta employees or companies with LADH employees, who wish to do business with La Academia Dolores Huerta.

The sample letters below all have requests which focus on three issues stipulated in state statute that allow the Governing Council to grant such a waiver.

These three issues are:

- 1. What is the employee's financial interest in the business?
- 2. How can it be assured that the employee is not going to be shown any bias or favoritism while conducting business with the LADH?
- 3. How are the best interests of the LADH met by approving a waiver for the employee?

Any request for a waiver must be submitted to the LADH Principal for consideration to be placed on the Governing Council agenda at an upcoming regular board meeting.

Information in addition to that provided on the completed waiver request form may or may not be needed by the Principal. It is, therefore, essential that any completed waiver request form contain complete contact information.

Any LADH employee to whom a waiver is granted by the Governing Council is required to follow strict procedures in conducting business at school sites. Enclosed herein is a NOTICE TO VENDORS that defines the necessary authority you must obtain and the approach you must take. On behalf of the LADH, your interest in doing business with the LADH is encouraged and appreciated.
